

Health Form / Policy Explanations

Annual Talmudical Academy Health Questionnaire:

The *Annual Talmudical Academy Health Questionnaire* must be filled out every year for ALL NEW (i.e. not enrolled at TA last year) and CONTINUING Talmudical Academy students by their parents/guardians and physician. The following non-prescription medications will be available in an effort to relieve minor discomforts which impede student learning and prevent full participation in classroom activities: Acetaminophen (Tylenol), Ibuprofen (Motrin or Advil), hydrocortisone, bacitracin, sunscreen, Tums, and Benadryl for allergic reactions only. **THIS FORM MUST BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED BY THE PHYSICIAN AND A PARENT BEFORE ANY MEDICATIONS WILL BE ADMINISTERED.**

Baltimore County Health Assessment:

The *Baltimore County Health Assessment* (including documentation of immunizations and lead testing) must be completed for all NEW students (i.e. not enrolled at TA last year) and all CONTINUING students entering the following grades: **Pre1a (Kindergarten), Grade 6, and Grade 9**. Those entering **Grade 7** need an updated immunization form only (not the complete Health Assessment). The **Baltimore County Health Assessment** must be completed by both parent/guardian and your physician. Parent/guardian completes Part I and your physician must complete Part II.

Parent's Request to Administer Medication in School:

All medications to be **regularly** administered at school, **PRESCRIPTION** and **OVER-THE-COUNTER**, must be accompanied by the *Parent's Request to Administer Medication in School Form* signed by the physician and parent. A parent must bring the medication to school in the **original container**. The order and medication must include name, date, dosage, instructions, and doctor's name. If your child starts a new medication, or the current dosage is adjusted, please notify the school immediately. **STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO CARRY OR SELF-ADMINISTER MEDICATION.** Please notify the nurse of special circumstances authorized by a physician.
