Restatement of Three Mesivta Rules

- **1. No student can bring a car to yeshiva.** (Any special situation must be worked out with Rabbi Oppen).
- 2. The Yeshiva is a place of learning. Therefore, only K phones are allowed in school. No electronic devices are allowed in school.
- **3.** Dress code includes the following:

Dress clothing

Dark pants

Dress shirts (no Hawaiian shirts or the like)

Dark or black shoes (no crocs or dark sneakers, etc.)

Socks must cover ankles

Only sweatshirts with the TA logo (purchased from the PTA) may be worn.

Yarmulkes must be appropriate size and in good taste.

Personal grooming including haircuts and facial hair must be befitting a boy in our Yeshiva.
