A PEEK INTO THIS MONTH ... SH

OVER ONE HUNDRED YEARS OF BUILDING TORAH

Parshas Shemini

In this week's *Parsha* we introduce many of the *halachos* and details of *Kashrus*. The last two *pesukim* of the *parsha* sum it up. לְהַבְּדִּיל בֵּין הַשְּׁמֵא וּבִין הַשָּׁמֵא וּבִין הַשָּׁמֵא וּבִין הַשָּׁמֵא וּבִין הַשָּׁהָר לֹא תֵאָכֵל:

— To distinguish between the contaminated and the pure, and between the creature that may be eaten and the creature that may not be eaten.

An *Adom Chashuv* once made the following observation. There are so many *Halachos* in the *Torah* regulating eating. What can be eaten, when it can be eaten and how it can be eaten. However, when it comes to *Davening*, there is only one *Pasuk* to command us to do so. (*Devarim* 11' 13). The spiritual side of man needs but one *Halacha*, however the physical part of man needs many rules and regulations. Why?

The reason is, that man's *Neshama* is naturally attuned to *Torah* and *Mitzvos*, which is our spirituality. However, the body is what needs to be disciplined and "conquered" in its *Avodas Hashem* to serve the *Neshamah*. Hence the myriad of *Mitzvos* to help in this *Avodah*.

The discipline a person brings to his *Guf*, body, will have a direct correlation to the *Neshama* of a person. *Yom Kippur* is the day of only spirit. We give up our bodily wants and desires for the day and connect to *Hashem* only on a

Ruchniyus plane. Purim is just the opposite. We try through the Mitvos of the day, eating a seudah, sending edibles to our brethren and presents for the poor, to connect to Hashem through our Guf. Truly a much harder Avodah for a person to accomplish.

We are a unique people unlike any other nation or religion. Our Avodas Hashem is a combination of our body and soul. One supporting the other. We cannot be only spiritual beings as we are human and have material needs. On the other hand, we should not be hedonistic beings that live only in the moment for the momentary pleasures. We must graft the two in reaching for the stars with our feet firmly planted in this world.

This week we lost a *Gadol BeTorah*. Many compared him to the great *Gedolim* of Pre-War Europe. In his 94 years here in this world Reb Chaim Kanievsky, ZT"L attained unthinkable spiritual heights. However, he related to all people in *Klal Yiroel* because he was a real person. His life was his *Torah* but he also lived to help his people navigate this world of *Guf* and *Nefesh*. He was *Kulo Torah*, but he was a human being that ate and drank. His body was totally disciplined to assist his *Neshama* to continuously grow.

May we be *Zocheh* to grow in our *Avodas Hashem*, with body and soul working together!


